3770:2-8-05 Removal from the Ohio voluntary exclusion program.

- (A) A participant <u>enrolled</u> in the Ohio VEP<u>will remain enrolled</u>, even after the program applicable exclusion period, identified in paragraph (C) of rule 3770:2-8-05 of the administrative code.
- (B) Upon reaching the selected minimum length of voluntary exclusion, an individual may request removal from the Ohio VEP.
- (B) (C) An individual may be removed from the one-year or five-year exclusion list by requesting and completing an unaltered application for removal.

(C) (D) An individual may be removed from the lifetime exclusion list, if the individual has:

- (1) Remained in the Ohio VEP for at least five years;
- (2) Completed the Ohio VEP education program on problem gambling awareness; and
- (3) Requested and completed an unaltered application for removal.
